Swiss Canoe would like to further increase the level of performance of the national canoe slalom teams and further develop the performance density at the top. To strengthen our team of coaches, we are looking for you as an experienced coach in the junior sector as of 1 January 2021 or by appointment. Together with the head coach junior canoe slalom you will be responsible for the development of the athletes of the C and D squads. As a junior national coach you are directly responsible to the head coach junior canoe slalom. In addition to supervising the athletes of the C and D squads at central and decentralised training measures and international competitions, as head of the regional performance centre (RPC) Bern-Biel, you will ensure the training operations at the RPC.

The scope of duties essentially comprises:

- Support of the head coach junior slalom in the supervision of the C and D squads of all boat classes on the occasion of training camps and competitions.
- Assistance in the preparation of the seasonal planning of the C, D squads and regional squads canoe slalom.
- Assistance in the organisation of training camps and the supply of international competitions for the C, D and regional squads (travel, accommodation, food, material, vehicles).
- Helping to draw up the general and individual training plans of the athletes based on the individual requirements and the training and competition analyses and performance tests in cooperation with the other trainers of the regional performance centres.
- Sports management of the RPC Bern-Biel and responsibility for the educational cooperation of the RPC and the collaboration with the affiliated canoe clubs.
- Close cooperation with the club trainers of the clubs affiliated to the RPC Bern-Biel.
- Support of the members of the RPC Bern-Biel in medium and long-term career planning.
- Collaboration in the strategic development of the canoe slalom promotion structure in cooperation with the sports director, the head coach canoe slalom and the other national coaches.

Our expectations of you:

- Experience as a coach in canoe slalom at international and national level with young athletes.
- Good organisational skills and motivating management style.
- Trainer diploma at the level of a professional trainer with a federal certificate or equivalent foreign training (e.g. DESJEPS, Trainer Academy Cologne etc.)
- Two of the following languages, written and spoken: German, French or English.
- Good user knowledge of the slalom analysis software Run Monitor.
- Good user knowledge in the MS Office applications Word, Excel and Powerpoint.
- Willingness to work irregular hours and travel (national/international).
- Willingness to work as a lecturer in the training of trainers.
- Ticket category D1E.
- Residence in a reasonable proximity to the places of work such as Bern, Biel/Bienne or Solothurn.
